

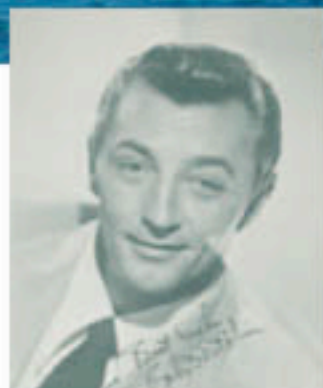

Her spacious decks and classically beautiful accommodation will ensure a pleasurable experience for you and your guests from the moment of embarkation.

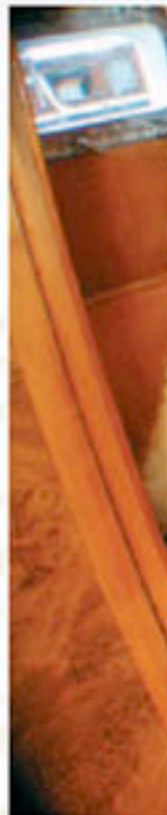

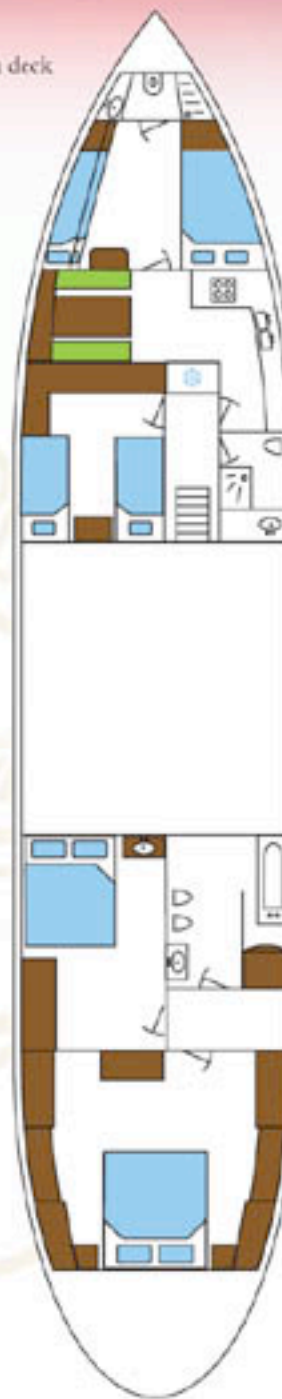
Sun deck
